§ 130.01 FIRING GUNS, FIREWORKS.

No person shall fire off or discharge any common gun, air gun, spring gun, target gun, Flobert rifle, fowling piece, pistol, or firearms of any description, or fire, explode, or set off any squib, crackers, or other thing containing powder or any other combustible material without permission from the council or written permission from the mayor, which permission shall limit the time of firing, and shall be subject to be revoked by the mayor or common council at any time after it has been granted. ('67 Code, §53.01) Penalty, see §130.99

§ 130.02 POSTING BILLS.

No person shall post or cause to be posted on any public or private wall, fence, or other structure, any printed advertisements, bills, or notice whatever without the permission of the owner or person having control of the same. ('67 Code, §53.02) Penalty, see §130.99

§ 130.03 SCHOOL VANDALISM

No person shall cut, break, deface, or otherwise injure any part of any schoolhouse belonging to the city, or the furniture thereof, or intentionally break any glass or sash in the windows of schoolhouses, or cut, break, or otherwise injure or destroy any tree growing on grounds belonging to the city and surrounding schoolhouses, or injure in any way the fences or gates enclosing schoolhouses and grounds. ('67 Code, §53.03) Penalty, see §130.99

§ 130.04 SLAUGHTERING ANIMALS.

No person keeping or running a meat market within the city shall slaughter or cause to be slaughtered within the city any animal(s), including hogs, cattle, sheep, or other animals. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry on the business of slaughtering animals for sale within the city limits, or to keep or maintain a slaughterhouse within the city limits. ('67 Code, §53.04) Penalty, see §130.00

§ 130.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provisions of this chapter shall be fined not more than \$100. ('67 Code, §53.99)
