

CITY OF DECATUR
SPECIAL BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING
JANUARY 27, 2016

The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety members met on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers 172 N. 2nd Street. The meeting was called to order by Mayor, Ken Meyer. Roll call showed board members Cameron Collier and Bill Karbach were present. Also present was Councilmen Craig Coshow, Matt Dyer, Tyler Fullenkamp, Wylie Sirk, and City Attorney, Tim Baker and Clerk-Treasurer, Phyllis Whitright.

Notice of the Special meeting was properly posted in City Hall, and the media was notified.

Collier made a motion to suspend the minutes from the previous meeting, until the regularly scheduled meeting. Karbach seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Previously discussed at the January 19th Board of Works meeting, Building Supt., Roger Gage handed out a proposal from Steamatic to replace a storm drainage pipe under the basement at 1143 Mix Avenue for \$8,946.00. The City Attorney, Tim Baker reported the storm sewer line was not listed on the plat when the house was constructed back in the 50's, so the basement was built over the pipe. Due to this being a City storm water line, and finding no documentation of an easement, Collier made a motion to pay the \$8,946.00 from the storm water utility fund, with consideration for the easement on this property. Karbach seconded the motion. Motion carried. The Building Supt., will contact the home owner of the Board of Works decision.

There being no further business, Collier made a motion for adjournment. Karbach seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 4:31p.m.
