

CITY OF DECATUR  
SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 20, 2020

The City of Decatur Common Council met on Friday, March 20, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers 172 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dan Rickord. Roll call was taken to show Councilmen Craig Coshow, Matt Dyer, Tyler Fullenkamp, Scott Murray, and Wylie Sirk were in attendance. Also present was City Attorney, Tim Baker and Clerk-Treasurer, Phyllis Whitright.

Notice of the Special meeting was properly posted at City Hall, and the media was notified.

Dyer made a motion to suspend the minutes from the March 3, 2020 meeting until the next regularly scheduled meeting. Sirk seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The purpose of the Special meeting was for the approval of claims that were prepared for the March 17<sup>th</sup> meeting. Coshow made a motion to approve the claims as presented. Sirk seconded the motion. Motion was unanimous.

The City Attorney informed the council members that due to the Corona Virus, the State Board of Account has now provided a Directive 2020-1 that allows the governing body to designate one of its members to approve claims for payment in advance of board allowance. The board must allow those claims at its first meeting after the Public Health Emergency has ended. Sirk made a motion to permit Councilman Craig Coshow to approve the claims during the emergency, and for Councilman Scott Murray to be the alternate. Dyer seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

There being no further business, Sirk made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dyer seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 3:19 p.m.
