

City of Decatur
Board of Public Works & Safety Minutes
April 19, 2022

The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety members met on Tuesday, April 19, 2022 at 6:00 P.M. Members present were Craig Coshow, Tyler Fullenkamp, and Mayor Dan Rickord. Also present were Clerk-Treasurer Phyllis Whitright and City Attorney Anne Razo.

The Clerk-Treasurer had emailed the minutes of the April 5, 2022 meeting. Fullenkamp made a motion to approve the minutes. Seconded by Coshow, the motion was adopted.

The first item on the agenda was the opening of sealed quotes that were solicited and prepared by Butler, Fairman and Seufert (BF&S) for Phase 1 of the 13th Street/Bollman Street Pedestrian Improvement Project which focused on signalization at the 13th Street/Bollman Street intersection along with the ADA curb ramp improvements. It was shared that the project is being done in partnership with INDOT as INDOT will reimburse the City a portion of the cost although the reimbursement may not be made until the fall. The one quote received was from Brooks Construction at \$166,597.00. Coshow made a motion for Jeremy Gilbert, City's Operations Manager to take the quote under advisement. Seconded by Fullenkamp, the motion was adopted.

Next on the agenda was the approval to pay App #2 for the Homestead Drainage Upgrades Project at a cost of \$176,076.99. Fullenkamp made a motion to pay App #2 for the Homestead Project at a cost of \$176,076.99 to VTF Excavation, LLC. Seconded by Coshow, the motion was adopted. Jeremy Gilbert, Operations Manager reported that the project will be completed within the week and then with seeding, the project will likely be totally completed in a month.

A nuisance violation was listed on the agenda, but Curt Witte, Building and Zoning Superintendent noted that the area had been cleaned up so there was no need for any action.

There being no other business to come before the Board, Fullenkamp made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Coshow, the motion was adopted.
