

CITY OF DECATUR  
SPECIAL MEETING  
COMMON COUNCIL  
MARCH 30, 2010

The City of Decatur Common Council met on Tuesday, March 30, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Schultz. Roll call was taken to show Councilwoman Barb Engle and Councilmen Charlie Cook, Bill Crone, Matt Dyer and Ken Meyer were in attendance. Also present was Clerk-Treasurer, Phyllis Whitright.

Cook made a motion to suspend the minutes from the previous meeting until the next regularly scheduled Common Council meeting on April 6th. Engle seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Special Meeting was held to interview applicants for the North Adams Community Schools Board, and for Council members to establish a method to appointment an applicant at the April 6<sup>th</sup> council meeting.

Mayor Schultz announced the meeting is open to the public to attend and observe, but the public does not have the right to participate in the interview process.

By consensus, the Council members decided when appointing a member to the North Adams Community Schools Board, the candidate must have at least three (3) votes to be selected.

There were seven (7) applicants, each applicant was interviewed individually, and asked the same set of questions.

Council members will select a School Board member at the April 6<sup>th</sup> Council meeting at City Hall in Council chambers at 7:30 p.m.

There being no further business, Engle made a motion for adjournment. Cook seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
