

CITY OF DECATUR
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MINUTES
APRIL 1, 2008

The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety met on Tuesday, April 1, 2008 at 6:00 P.M. in City Hall. Members present were Mayor John Schultz and Board Members Bill Karbach and Ken Meyer. City Attorney, Tim Baker was also present.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Schultz. The Clerk-Treasurer mailed the minutes from the March 18th meeting. With no additions or corrections offered, Karbach made a motion to approve the minutes as mailed, seconded by Meyer. Motion carried.

The mayor reported that the Fire Chief, Les Marckel has not found a vehicle yet to replace the 1996 Suburban. An ad for bids will be in the Decatur Daily Democrat for the 1952 Fire Truck.

Meyer made a motion to make the Certificate of Appointments for Greg Cook as Deputy Chief, Lenny Corral, and Chris Brite as Sergeants a matter of record. Karbach seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A decision whether to purchase a city flag was tabled until there is a special year to celebrate the city's birthday.

The mayor handed out copies from the city code of ordinance book on parking on municipal lots. Customer convenience permits were established in 1995, but was not utilized. Board member, Bill Karbach will contact downtown merchants to get their feedback on parking issues.

The board members made some minor changes for the purchasing ordinance, now the mayor will present the ordinance at the Department Head meeting on April 15th to get their input.

There being no further business, Meyer made a motion for adjournment. Karbach seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
