SPECIAL MEETING
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MINUTES
APRIL 29, 2008

The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety met on Tuesday, April 29, 2008 at 2:00 P.M. at City Hall in Council Chambers. Members present were Mayor John Schultz and Board Member Bill Karbach. Board Member Ken Meyer was absent. Also present was City Attorney, Tim Baker.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Schultz. The meeting was properly posted.

Karbach made a motion to make the legal advertisement for bids for the Wastewater Utility Improvement Projects a matter of record. Schultz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The City Attorney opened the bids and Ben Adams of Commonwealth Engineers read the bids aloud. All bids included a bid bond of 5% of the total bid amount along with a completed Indiana Bid Form 96.
