

CITY OF DECATUR
COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 16, 2008

The City of Decatur Common Council met on Tuesday, September 16, 2008 at 7:30 P.M. at City Hall in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Schultz. Roll call was taken to show Councilwoman Barb Engle and Councilmen Charlie Cook, Bill Crone, Matt Dyer, and Ken Meyer were in attendance. Also present was City Attorney, Tim Baker.

The Clerk-Treasurer had emailed the minutes from the September 2nd council meeting. There were no additions or corrections offered so Dyer made a motion to approve the minutes as received. Cook seconded the motion. All council members were in favor. Motion carried.

The Mayor invited everyone to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor reported that he and the Clerk-Treasurer attended the budget review meeting with County Council on September 5th. No recommendations were given by County Council. The County will hold another meeting once the assessed valuation is known. The Mayor praised County Auditor, Bill Borne for being so helpful with the budget changes.

The Mayor asked for a moment of silence for Paul Rich who passed away on September 10th. Rich was a retired Police Officer and WBZD radio announcer.

Street Commissioner, Jeremy Gilbert reported LICA Construction will be paving the water cuts in the streets. On Wednesday, Sept. 23rd LICA will begin paving some of the trenches from the CSO Project.

The Mayor introduced Bob Adams from WBZD radio who was replacing Paul Rich.

Councilman Cook reported the Plan Commission approved the site plan for a new office building to be constructed by Arnold Company at 720 S. 13th Street for RT & T Investments.

Engle made a motion to allow the claims as presented. Cook seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business, Dyer made a motion for adjournment. Engle seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
