SPECIAL MEETING
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MINUTES
NOVEMBER 19, 2009

The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety met on Thursday, November 19, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers. Members present were Mayor John Schultz, Board members Bill Karbach and Ken Meyer. Also present was Clerk-Treasurer, Phyllis Whitright.

The meeting was properly posted and faxed to the Decatur Daily Democrat and The Journal Gazette.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Schultz. Karbach made a motion to suspend the minutes from the previous meeting until the regularly scheduled Board of Works meeting on Tuesday, December 1st, Meyer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A decision was made on holiday pay for the employees being paid for 32 hours a week, if there is two (2) holidays in that work week, then they would be compensated for one day of holiday pay.

The special meeting was held to interview five (5) applicants for the Utilities Auditor position.

The City Attorney prepared a list of questions to be asked to the applicants. Meyer made a motion to approve the questions, Karbach seconded the motion. Motion carried.
