The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety met on Wednesday, November 7, 2022 immediately following the Executive Session at City Hall in Council Chambers starting at 3:45 p.m. Members present were Mayor Dan Rickord, Craig Coshow and Tyler Fullenkamp. Also present was Police Chief, Lennie Corral, City Attorney, Anne Razo and Clerk-Treasurer, Phyllis Whitright.

Notice of the Special Meeting was posted in City Hall at least 48 hours prior to the meeting, and *The Decatur Daily Democrat* and *The Berne Witness* were notified by email.

The Special Meeting was held to determine suspending a police officer in excess of five (5) days and offer the officer an opportunity for a disciplinary hearing.

Fullenkamp made a motion to suspend Officer Teddy Bessesen, Jr. with pay pending notice of rights to be delivered to the Officer and to further assess disciplinary actions available in accordance with IC 36-8-3-4 at a Special Board of Public Works & Safety meeting and Hearing to be held on Monday, November 28, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. Coshow seconded the motion. Motion carried.
