

SPECIAL MEETING
CITY OF DECATUR
COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES
DECEMBER 27, 2022

A Special Meeting of the City of Decatur Common Council was held on Tuesday, December 27, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers, 172 N. Second Street. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dan Rickord. Roll call was taken to show Councilmen Craig Coshow, Matt Dyer, Tyler Fullenkamp, Scott Murray, and Wylie Sirk were in attendance. Also present were City Attorney Anne Razo, and Clerk-Treasurer Phyllis Whitright.

The Special Council Meeting was posted in City Hall at least 48 hours prior to the meeting, and the media was notified by email.

Dyer made a motion to suspend the approval of the minutes from December 20th until the next regular meeting, which will be January 3, 2023. Murray seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The City Attorney stated the purpose for the Special meeting was for the final reading of Ordinance 2022-24 that was read and passed on its first two readings at the previous meeting of December 20, 2022. The Ordinance amends Chapter 31 of the 2015 Decatur Code of Ordinances regarding Council Districts for the City of Decatur to be submitted to the Adams County Commissioners and the Indiana Election Division to be effective for all elections occurring after January 1, 2023. There was no public present to speak for or against, so Sirk made a motion to place Ordinance 2022-24 on its Third and Final reading by short title only, seconded by Murray. Motion passed. The City Attorney read the Ordinance by short title only. Sirk made a motion to Adopt Ordinance 2022-24, Murray seconded the motion. The Clerk-Treasurer did a roll call vote, with Coshow, Dyer, Fullenkamp, Murray and Sirk all voting in favor and none opposed.

There being no other business. Coshow made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Dyer seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 10:28 a.m.
